## Three levels of transformation Online Mentoring Nr. 144 - Atlanta - 17. July 2014

Psalm 139 Search me oh God...Heb.4:12 The living word, Jesus, separates soul and spirit and re-integrates it. He separates the **thoughts**, **motives & intentions of our heart**. You deal with the **three things from outside in**.

When you are dealing with stuff from the **inside out** you are <u>cleaning your gateways</u>. That frees us from the **behavioral patterns** that we established. They are blockages and hindrances in our soul gates. That then floods from the inside out. But the two go together as we learn to work at things. But ultimately we have to find the root. (seed, root, fruit). Root of iniquity, of sin etc.

Embrace the transformation process, so you become whole! The more we become transformed into the image of God the more authority and power will be released because we will be recognized as the children of God. We get recognized in the realm of heaven. That is a spiritual thing; angels and other spiritual beings recognize the authority that we carry.

Our soul wants to be recognized for what we do, surface issues. The soul looks to provides for its own needs, we then look for affirmation, affection, approval from people for what we do instead of just being who we are (trading!).

We really need to know who we are, as what God created us to be. So we can be realigned and conformed to that.

Three things have shaped us: Nurture, nature & trauma. Trauma is a major one. It can set up instant neural-pathways to memories that continue to influence us. Sometimes that can cause dissociation or stuck parts where we are emotionally undeveloped or immature in an area. We need to identify those things or they will trigger us back to behaving according to the memories of those traumas. Even our cells can contain the record of trauma. They need a trauma release. Trauma usually creates fear and the enemy comes in and occupies that.

## Question: What do I do when I have reached a plateau and can't go any further?

There are different levels. Most inner healing and deliverance dealt with the behavioral level. Now we look to engage in a deeper level in the realms of the kingdom we also need to go to a deeper level in those things.

If you dealt with the **surface level** – the skins of **behavior** (coping and defense mechanism) that will get you as far as the **kingdom of God**, you are dealing with some dragons and giants. But if you want to engage in **kingship** you need to go **deeper and deal with the thoughts, motives & intentions of the heart, the trading!!.** 

That is a deeper level. It goes on like that. If we want to come into true sonship, we need genetic transformation. We cannot be sons of God carrying serpent- nephilim seed or other. That is again a deeper level.

It is normal to reach these plateaus, just don't stay there. The authority that we will be given is proportionate to the level of holiness that we live in. We will not get it if there is a risk we use it for ourselves. Many "great" people have fallen because they were not accountable for those inner motives (getting affirmation etc. from outside).

Whoever is stuck, has not dealt with those things! You cannot be in government (heavenly positions of rulership) without being a living sacrifice. If you are not actually on the altar then you will not get the position that you should have. It is hard work, you need to repent of all your wrong motives "Lord, in that whole period of my live my motives were absolute egoistic!" **Trading!** 

God will not continue using people with unclean hearts. They will end up as Ananias & Saphira. – It is very important to deal with things on a day to day basis. Don't sleep with the enemy. If you don't deal with that (forgiveness) before going to bed, the enemy has a whole night to work in your memories and create links in them etc.

Every day I have to choose to deny myself, to apply the cross and walk in holiness. I want to do NOTHING that brings disrepute to God in my attitudes, my speech, in everything about me. I want my conscience to direct me to demonstrate holiness. When the old nature is dead (died with Christ) the problem is my flesh. My flesh has a choice: Surrender to God, or go my own way.

If you are out of rest (seat of rest) you cannot administer anything. If I am not in that place of rest I can go to my throne as much as I like & decree, declare etc. but I am not coming out of a place of peace and wholeness.

## Question: Can I tell other people their motives?

You must have a very, very good relationship with someone to be able to point out the motives of their heart.

You have to have a solid foundation of relationship to be able to share those types of issues with each other and reveal blind-self-issues. I very often see the motives (but don't point them out). But when you do have those relationships were you can give people permission, they are very valuable! Then they can help you to see what you don't see.

For me (Mike) it was pro-active. I wanted the thoughts and intentions of my heart resolved. I asked God to search my heart and show me everything that was in there, all hardness, memories, stones, weeds, anxieties. I asked him to take me to the court to put me on trial and show me where I was not coming out of peace and rest in my life. I continually, day after day, presented myself for that process and God showed me.

You could use liebusting. I personally had built up a relationship with God that I myself heard him telling me all those things. Whoever struggles to hear what God is saying would need some support or help. But I would encourage learning to hear God for yourself.

Renew your mind; start to think differently, act differently as a way to walk into freedom is important. You can use the judicial system to get free, but you still have to apply the separation. Even if you have a court order "I am divorced from this pattern of thinking" you still have to apply it every day and take every pattern of thought captive. Otherwise it is just a piece of paper. Just a paper does not do anything, you have to enforce the authority that you have to place it under your feet and you are over it.

There are lots of issues you have to go through to deal with those things. The hardest of the three layers are the motives of the heart! It could come from nurture, nature or trauma, but it is <u>MY heart</u> and I am responsible and I need to deal with it. If I blame anybody else, then I have not forgiven and released them!

I have to release anything anyone has done to me, no matter who, when and where. I have to release them from the debts that are outstanding, so that those debts can be cancelled, so I can be free and God can do whatever he needs to do in that situation. **Forgiveness is vital!!** 

In recovery people have to make an inventory of their life. Every Christian should learn to do that:

What am I thinking?

What are my attitudes?

What are my emotions?

What is my speech like?

If I am willing to do that on a daily basis it is a good starting point in showing me the things I need to deal with. It does take discipline. But if you have a great enough desire you are willing to discipline yourself. If not, then you need to cultivate desire!
