

**Process of transformation** (Supernatural Mentoring No.109 - Atlanta)

I (Mike) did a crash-course (in the transformational process) as a forerunner. God gave me a lot of grace for it. I went through the gateways and every year of my life. When it then came to presenting myself as a living sacrifice (looking at the thoughts and intentions of the heart), I found that that is where a lot of the bloodline things and those iniquitous patterns are.

I found that it was not until I started to deal with things at a genetic level using communion to transform the triggers and the patterns of genetic behavior, that I got ultimate breakthrough.

I had breakthrough when I understood the nature of the iniquitous patterns and I recognized them, repented, renounced things and took those things to the court. Some of it was familiar spirits that were assigned to my generational line and to my life. They were not easy to get rid of. I had to re-enforce my authority over and over again. I kept taking them back to the court until they felt the judgement of God being released and stopped.

I persisted over a short period of time. I think 40 days is a very significant biblical time! If you can consistently work through a thing for a 40-day-period (about 6 weeks), you can break old mindsets and establish new ones. But you have to be consistent.

Sometimes it is like knocking down a wall, hitting it with a sledge hammer. You don't see a lot in the beginning, but every time you hit it with the hammer you are weakening the wall and eventually it will come down. You don't necessarily always see the fruit in a lot of what we are doing but you are being effective and eventually the whole thing just comes down. I used to give people a forty-day-battle-plan: 2 weeks to embrace something new – 2 weeks to establish that as a pattern of life – 2 weeks to really engage in it.

Whoever was willing to do that for the 40 days, for them it became a lifestyle. But it is a battle to stick to it!

When I eventually reached the deepest level (bone and marrow), I would daily take communion (every time I ate, I focused on that). Then God showed me some of the genetic seed roots of my issues. Some were almost irrational; I could not explain why I had certain behavior patterns or thinking patterns. I had looked already if there was a particular sin generationally. It was only when I finally identified that this was genetic material in my DNA that came from before the flood and was able to transform that by taking communion and directing the life of God, the blood of Jesus, the DNA of God to transform that area back into the original condition, so that I can be like Jesus, that I actually saw total breakthrough.

There were certain things that I had struggled with, then there were months without struggle and I thought that is sorted out and then I suddenly got hit by a behavior or

mindset again. It came out of the blue, now I know it was triggered genetically rather than in my emotions/soul. When I dealt with that those things no longer had any influence. But it did take some time.

Dealing with all the “ites”, the trading floors, the thoughts and intentions of my own heart: Owning them, repenting and renouncing was all part of that process that uncovered what was hidden in my genetic material. If I had not done it, the rest of the things would not have been uncovered and I would not have been able to deal with it. In a sense you are working from the outside in; while with the gateways you are working from the inside out.

When I am looking at these things I am looking at my behaviors, my thoughts and motivations of my heart that lead to those behaviors. Then I am looking at what might be there as actual genetic material that leads me towards that (acts as trigger).

You really have to be persistent and consistent with it (God told me to be diligent and vigilant!) it is hard work.

***Question: Do we need revelation of certain things in the past or can we just take a blanket approach (do we have to take every one of the 40 kings into court or just all of them together). Do we need revelation of things that took place pre-flood?***

When it comes to the liebusting process it is about asking God what happened and in what generation. You don't need to go into minute detail, but if there is a specific thing that took place that gave legal authority to the enemy, then it is useful to deal with that legal authority, particularly if a covenant thing has been made or blood has been shed or something specific like that set up a pattern in the family or gave access to the enemy to do something in the family, then it is useful to know.

When I dealt with the kings and the “ites” etc., I just went through the list and asked God to show me if any of them had any influence. Probably about five or six had an influence and I dealt with those. I went to the court and demanded that they tell me why they are here. This is a similar process to liebusting. In one you are dealing with the enemy and asking him to reveal it, in the other you are asking God to reveal what the enemy did.

The liebusting style of it deals with the event and you forgive and release the person. You deal with what happened in your life and how it is affecting you. Dealing with it in the court gives you ongoing judicial authority to enforce what is being done.

Sometimes, if you don't have that ongoing judicial authority, the enemy will try to come back and trick you into the lie that he is still operating. But when you know you have judicial authority “I know I am separated from you, I have divorce papers. And if you persist in this you are going to get the judgement of God released on you if you ever come back into my thoughts this way”, then you enforce it this way. You bring that out of heaven and enforce it on a daily basis.

When I dealt with genetic things, I started to take the bread and the wine. I would just stand on the dance floor of God's presence and I would ask his DNA to come round me, his light to come around me. I looked for the areas where darkness was. I then had certain memories and flashbacks of certain things which were from that period. I saw some things from before the flood, some from after. I then specifically targeted them for transformation.

Psalm 139: Search me oh God and know my Heart, try me (put me on trial) and show me my anxious thoughts (the way of thinking that the enemy uses). Show me if there is any wicked (idolatrous) iniquitous way in me. – That goes particularly down to the genetic level where there is genetic material. It is material that should not be there. It is not mine; it is not what God intended. It has come because of the human condition.

The more information you have the more you know which things to be on guard about. Sometimes it seems like "...will it ever finish?" It does! Today I spend 99,9% of my time thinking about God and very little being engaged with the enemy. I am not interested in that stuff anymore. My heart is consumed with my relationship with God. That did not just happen. It took choices and decisions on a daily basis.

Every day I still surrender and give the government of my life to God, I joke myself to Jesus, I go before the ark and present myself as a living sacrifice. Every time I do that I remind God that he has permission to show me anything that may still need dealing with. We do go through seasons where everything seems great and then another season comes where God shows us things on a deeper level. We have to be willing to respond to that.

I have another teaching about turning trauma into transformation in which I teach that you can look at your reaction to everyday situations as a key to find out if there are still things operating. "Why did I do or say or think that?" And then be open for the Holy Spirit to show you if there are things in your daily life which are not coming out of God. It takes humility and a willingness to be honest with ourselves.

I personally know when I am reacting rather than responding to something. If I am reacting to something then I want to know what is causing that reaction (rather than giving a godly response). I still use that at times to check if everything is o.k. If things are not quite right then I will find out why. But generally I don't go digging for stuff because the majority has been dealt with. God has permission to show me anything he wants.
