Unforgiveness keeps you in prison. Unforgiveness keeps you in chains and bondage.





- Disciples rejected him.

Isaiah 53

He didn't look like anything or anyone of consequence—he had no physical beauty to attract our attention.³ So he was despised and forsaken by men ,this man of suffering, grief's patient friend. As if he was a person to avoid, we looked the other way; he was despised, forsaken, and we took no notice of him. Yet it was our suffering he carried, our pain and distress, our sick-to-the-soul-ness.

We just figured that God had rejected him, that God was the reason he hurt so badly. ⁵ But he was hurt because of us; he suffered so. Our wrongdoing wounded and crushed him. He endured the breaking that made us whole. The injuries he suffered became our healing. ⁶ We all have wandered off, like *shepherdless* sheep, scattered by our aimless striving and endless pursuits; The Eternal One laid on him, this silent sufferer, the sins of us all.

And in the face of such oppression and suffering—silence.Not a word of protest, not a finger raised to stop it. Like a sheep to a shearing, like a lamb to be slaughtered, he went—oh so quietly, oh so willingly.8 Oppressed and condemned, he was taken away. From this generation, who was there to complain? Who was there to cry "Foul"? He was, after all, cut off from the land of the living, Smacked and struck, not on his account,

Forgive and Release 2 because of how my people (my people!)Disregarded the lines between right and wrong. They snuffed out his life. ⁹ And when he was dead, he was buried with the disgraced in borrowed space (among the rich), Even though he did no wrong by word or deed.

 You're not going to settle rejection issues fully until you get it down into your spirit that you are accepted, loved, and appreciated by God. Dealing with religious strongholds is vital to this process, as religion paints God as distant, cold, and impersonal. Bringing your relationship with God into proper perspective is a vital step in the process of overcoming the strongholds of rejection.

Isaiah 61 The Spirit of the Lord GOD is upon me, Because the LORD has anointed me To bring good news to the afflicted; He has sent me to bind up the brokenhearted, To proclaim liberty to captives And freedom to prisoners; To proclaim the favourable year of the LORD And the day of vengeance of our God;

- To comfort all who mourn, To grant those who mourn in Zion, Giving them a garland instead of ashes, The oil of gladness instead of mourning, The mantle of praise instead of a spirit of fainting. So they will be called oaks of righteousness,
- The planting of the LORD, that He may be glorified.

- Instead of your shame you will have a double portion,
- And instead of humiliation they will shout for joy over their portion.
- Therefore they will possess a double portion in their land,
- Everlasting joy will be theirs.
- For I, the LORD, love justice,
- I hate robbery in the burnt offering;
- And I will faithfully give them their recompense
- And make an everlasting covenant with them.

- Then their offspring will be known among the nations,
- And their descendants in the midst of the peoples.
- All who see them will recognize them
- Because they are the offspring whom the LORD has
- blessed.
- I will rejoice greatly in the LORD,
