- So I answered, "I'm coming. I read in your letter what you wrote about me, And I'm coming to the party you're throwing for me." That's when God's Word entered my life, became part of my very being.

- We were created in eternity. God knew us before we were formed in our mothers womb, before we were born into this realm as a physical being. We existed before we had a physical body. We were first created as a spirit out of the heart of God. We are made in Gods image and God is spirit.
- God wrote a book about us and what our destiny should be which is contained in our spirit.

- The natural way of thinking is that we have a physical body with a soul. However you are a spirit that has a soul (mind, will and emotions) that lives in a body. The real you is the spiritual person.
- When we become Christians this is where our thinking needs to change. Up to this point everything about us is fed from the world and we live from the outside in. We are totally led by our soul needs.

 At salvation our spirit becomes reconnected to God and we have a relationship with Him that transforms us from the inside out, We are connected to heaven and all its resources and this now forms the basis of our new life. We need to learn to grow our spirit so we are spirit led and become more like Jesus and learn to live a supernatural lifestyle. This means basically unlearning everything and starting again God's way!

- ²⁶⁻²⁸ God spoke: "Let us make human beings in our image, make them

So they can be responsible for the fish in the sea, the birds in the air, the cattle,

Genesis 1:26 Then God said, "Let Us (Father, Son, Holy Spirit) make man in Our image, according to Our likeness [not physical, but a spiritual personality and moral likeness]; and let them have complete authority over the fish of the sea, the birds of the air, the cattle, and over the entire earth, and over everything that creeps and crawls on the earth." ²⁷ So God created man in His own image, in the image and likeness of God He created him; male and female He created them. ²⁸ And God blessed them [granting them certain authority] and said to them, "Be fruitful, multiply, and fill the earth, and subjugate it [putting it under your power]; and rule over (dominate) the fish of the sea, the birds of the air, and every living thing that moves upon the earth."

- What was God's intent for man?
- Look at Adam.
- Significant he had a purpose to rule and subdue the earth.
- Safe and secure God provided for all his needs.
- Belonging he had an intimate relationship with God.

• ²⁹ So God said, "Behold, I have given you every plant yielding seed that is on the surface of the entire earth, and every tree which has fruit yielding seed; it shall be food for you; ³⁰ and to all the animals on the earth and to every bird of the air and to everything that moves on the groundto everything in which there is the breath of life—I have given every green plant for food"; and it was so [because He commanded it]. ³¹ God saw everything that He had made, and behold, it was very good *and* He validated it completely.


- Gen 36 The woman approached the tree, eyed its fruit, and coveted its mouth-watering, wisdom-granting beauty. She plucked a fruit from the tree and ate. She then offered the fruit to her husband who was close by, and he ate as well. 7 Suddenly their eyes were opened to a reality previously unknown. For the first time, they sensed their vulnerability and rushed to hide their naked bodies, stitching fig leaves into crude loincloths. 8 Then they heard the sound of the Eternal God walking in the cool misting shadows of the garden. The man and his wife took cover among the trees and hid from the Eternal God.
- God (calling to Adam): 9 Where are you?
- Adam: 10 When I heard the sound of You coming in the garden, I was afraid because I am naked. So I hid *from You*.
- **God:** ¹¹ Who told you that you are naked? Have you eaten from the tree *in the centre of the garden*, the very one I commanded you not to eat from?
- **Adam** (pointing at the woman): 12 It was she! The woman You gave me as a companion put the fruit in my hands, and I ate it.

- **God:** ²² Look, the human has become like one of Us, possessing the knowledge of good and evil. *If We don't do something*, he will reach out his hand and take *some of the fruit* from the tree of life, eat it, and live forever.
- ²³ So the Eternal God banished Adam and Eve from the garden of Eden and exiled humanity from paradise, sentencing humans to laborious lives working the very ground man came from. ²⁴ After driving them out, He stationed winged guardians at the east end of the garden of Eden and set up a sword of flames which *alertly* turned back and forth to guard the way to the tree of life.

- What effect did this have?
- Spiritual death.
- Lost knowledge of God.
- Dominant Negative emotions:
- Rejected therefore a need to belong.
- Fear no security.
- Guilt and shame a need for self worth.
- No purpose, weak and helpless need to control.

- What were strengths became weaknesses:
- Acceptance and belonging rejection.
- Innocence guilt and shame.
- Authority helplessness, weakness, need to control.
- Significance and purpose lack of identiy.

- John 3:3Amplified Bible (AMP)
- •3 Jesus answered him, "I assure you and most solemnly say to you, unless a person is born again [reborn from above—spiritually transformed, renewed, sanctified], he cannot [ever] see and experience the kingdom of God."

- New life Brings a new identity
- •2 Corinthians 5 17. Therefore if anyone is in Christ [that is, grafted in, joined to Him by faith in Him as Saviour], he is a new creature [reborn and renewed by the Holy Spirit]; the old things [the previous moral and spiritual condition] have passed away. Behold, new things have come [because spiritual awakening brings a new life].

Colossians 1:13Amplified Bible (AMP)

- ¹³ For He has rescued us *and* has drawn us to Himself from the dominion of darkness, and has transferred us to the kingdom of His beloved Son,
- That means we have literally changed kingdoms!

- For we are His workmanship [His own master work, a work of art], created in Christ Jesus [reborn from above—spiritually transformed, renewed, ready to be used] for good works, which God prepared [for us] beforehand [taking paths which He set], so that we would walk in them [living the good life which He prearranged and made ready for us].


- The person you became at salvation did not exist before!

- Becoming a Christian is not a matter of getting something, but of 'being' someone.
- Were a sinner, now a SAINT.
- How you see yourself is vital.
- What do sinners do?
- What do saints do? Float on a cloud?
- Saint is a person who has been transformed by Jesus and all that means

- Basically at salvation we have -
- A new birth spiritually alive.
- A new identity new species.
- A new title Saint, a holy person.
- A new family child of God.
- A new life free from sin
- A new start slate is wiped clean.
- A new kingdom to live in.
- A chance to fulfil our destiny know God intimately and rule our spheres of influence.

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- Okay if that's the case why are there so many Christians with low self esteem, who have a problem living victoriously, who struggle with sin, relating to God as Father, taking spiritual responsibility, who aren't mature, don't have God's character and don't display the fruits of the spirit. Basically who are totally defeated in their spiritual lives?
- Could be they are not pursuing God and living sinful lives.
- Could be they are still living according to the worlds value system.



conception to birth;


all the stages of my life were spread out before you,

Romans 8 19 For all of creation is waiting, yearning for the time when the children of God will be revealed. 20 You see, all of creation has collapsed into emptiness, not by its own choosing, but by God's. Still He placed within it a deep and abiding hope 21 that creation would one day be liberated from its slavery to corruption and experience the glorious freedom of the children of God. 22 For we know that all creation groans in unison with birthing pains up until now. ²³ And there is more; it's not just creation—all of us are groaning together too.

The crown of God's creation is a new creature, a creature that can sound the heartbeat of its Creator. That creature, made male and female, reflects God's own relational richness. The human family is to join God in the ongoing work of creation. The earth below and the sky above with all their inhabitants are too beautiful and too good to be left alone. They need the tender care and close attention that only God's favoured creature can give.
