How do Benches of Three Function Governmentally?


Matt 6:10 'Your kingdom come. Your will be done, On earth as it is in heaven.


- Heavenly government is made up of various courts, councils and assemblies made up of Father, Son and Holy Spirit with angelic beings, Elders, members of the cloud of witnesses and us
- Benches of 3, 7 and 12
- Sods of God Council of 70, Courts and Assembles that rule governmentally in the heavenlies

- What is a Bench of three?
- Beit Din is the Hebrew term for a governmental judicial council that is a reflection of God's heavenly government of the Father, Son and Holy Spirit
- It is both relational and governmental in heaven and on earth

- House Ekklesia or Qahal needed 10 to form around a blueprint
- Bench of 3 is a foundation not a hierarchy
- Angel of the House who is the apostolic representative of the 7
- Bench of 7 bring priestly agreement between heaven and earth
- All operating according to 4 faces of God

- Pastoral earthly verses apostolic heavenly a battle for who rules and how things are governed
- Earthly pastoral, prophetic or apostolic coverings of old covenant mediatorial hierarchical government





- Bench of 3, Beit Din or Apostolic Council provide apostolic strategic direction and governmental foundations
- Engages heaven and brings apostolic blueprints
- Judicial authority to administer with righteousness and justice

- You have a heavenly mandate and blueprint but what then?
- Establish foundational government of ideally a Bench of 3
- Things don't always work out ideally in the real world
- What if there are not three people?

- Sometimes 1 person agrees with God for a blueprint and forms an arc with God then starts to call for others to resonate
- Heaven's government (angel, witness)
- Sometimes you have 2 in agreement as an arc and God becomes the 3rd for government
- Sometimes you have 3 in government and God forms the 4th for door to be opened

- Benches form in many ways
- All benches need to be relational
- Personal examples how our benches formed and function
- How this regional bench formed
- You work through issues that come up relationally to come into agreement

- Who can be part of a bench of 3?
- Anyone who God calls and who is willing to foundationally serve the blueprint that God has released.
- There would have to be the ability to pursue engaging God in the heavenly realms and the willingness to continue maturing

- Those willing to operate in mutual submission and create a culture of honour and be open, honest and transparent.
- Those willing to release others into their destinies
- Those willing to stepped on to provide the support for blueprints

- There will be many very different blueprints and there can be different benches within blueprints.
- We have a Bench of 3, 7 and 12 and each of our mountain spheres have benches of 3.

- What experience is desirable for one on such a bench?
- God would rather have an amateur in the new than a professional in the old.
- The desire and willingness to hear God's voice and see what He is doing from a heavenly perspective is far more important than earthly experience of old leadership models.

- Ability to bring a heavenly order of Melchizedek perspective
- Priest, King, Prophet (Oracle) Apostle (Legislator)
- Bench is a governmental role
- Redemptive gift ruler, prophet or teacher may be helpful but not mandatory

- How is a bench set in place, by a democratic vote or by a heavenly appointment and by whom?
- It depends on the situations.
- Establishing a new blueprint and forming the foundational government for it from scratch would be very different from transitioning from an old church structure.

- I have been personally involved in both set of circumstances and it usually involves someone or a group seeking God for and receiving heavenly revelation of the blueprint
- Or the existing leadership seeking God to clarify the vision that they may already have from a heavenly perspective and seeing it in blueprint form.

- There is no democracy in heaven but there is always unity and agreement so any bench would have to accept God's heavenly appointment by being of one heart, mind and purpose.
- The issue of senior leadership within a bench is to me the old trying to control and influence the new.

- Does the bench function under the principle of total agreement before making decisions?
- Yes if there is no agreement then there is no unity and therefore no commanded blessing.
- We always seek agreement with God and as we submit to Him we will be in agreement with each other.

 This takes the development of trust which comes through helping each other work through the issues that will inevitably arise as we are all in the process of transformation.

- Anyone seeking earthly recognition or validation of themselves or their identity from being part of a bench need to be willing to recognise and work through these types of issues
- Things will come to the surface that will bring transformation and maturity

- There is always accountability within any government
- This accountability is first to God for the out working of our destiny
- We are accountable to God for the blueprints being administered
- We are accountable to each other as bench members for our roles
